Concessions - Thanks to all of our amazing volunteers for getting us through the Madison Bowl! It was a wild ride for sure, but we survived!

We have discovered that we need to adjust everyone's arrival time for concession volunteers due to the training, paperwork, and prep work that needs to take place prior to us opening the stands. Going forward, the arrival time for each shift has been moved up by one half hour. If you have already signed up, you most likely have received an email from me explaining this. You will still get an email reminder from me the day before the game.

Also, a few housekeeping notes:

- 1. It is important that you understand that you are expected to stay after the game is over to help count inventory, sweep, mop, clean, breakdown boxes, take out trash, etc. Please plan on hanging around for 45 min to one hour after the game is over.
- 2. If you are concerned about your child having to wait on you on the visitor side after the game, please tell them to walk over to the concession stand and wait while you complete your shift. Also, there are several parents that hang around after the game with the band kids and will make sure that your child is safe until you can meet up with them.
- 3. Please make sure to arrive on time for your shift. If you are late, this makes it difficult for the other volunteers as they have to complete your duties.
- 4. When you arrive for your shift, please sign in and then sign the food service agreement. After this is done, you will be given instructions for your specific job.

Your cooperation in following these instructions is crucial to us having a successful and less chaotic night.
